(11 total sessions; no class Thanksgiving week)

Make a difference through the arts. In this program, you'll join a group of teens passionate about art to make an impact on the Museum and our community. We'll discover works of art in-depth and connect them to our lives today. We'll go behind the scenes and meet Museum staff to learn about arts careers and develop your own resume. You'll share your passion for art with elementary school students. For your final project, you'll create an innovative collaborative project culminating in a performance and reception at the museum.

- **Free internship program**
- Sessions take place at the Milwaukee Art Museum once a week on Wednesdays
- **Free dinner and bus tickets or parking passes** are provided for accepted students
- Students will explore cross-disciplinary approaches using art and writing, developing personal voice
- You should be interested in the arts, but you do not need to be an artist to apply
