 - Demonstrate writing-to-learn strategies that support student understanding without increasing teaching workload.
 - Explore ways to motivate students to become better and more powerful readers and writers.
 - Work with your team, or individually, to develop an Action Plan to help other teachers realize the benefits of writing-to-learn and writing workshop.
- FEES AND CREDIT:** **Applicants have the option of participating in the Institute for credit or non credit.** Earn 3 graduate education credits from Carroll University.
A grant from the National Writing Project allows us to offer 50% reduce graduate credit cost for a total of \$220/credit (2011-2012 rate).
