Background Information:

The Anthony Petullo Collection of Self-Taught and Outsider Art is one of the premier collections of its kind in the country. Comprised of nearly three hundred works of art, two-thirds of which are European, the collection consists of works ranging from the early twentieth-century to the present, and includes many of the most renowned American artists in the field such as Bill Traylor, Henry Darger, and Minnie Evans. The distinguishing characteristic of the collection, however, is the strong emphasis on the work of European outsider artists. In 2010, Petullo gave the bulk of his collection to the Milwaukee Art Museum, comprising more than 300 drawings, paintings and sculptures. Along with artwork, Petullo donated the materials for this manuscript collection.

Anthony Petullo, an entrepreneur and author, built his collection over a span of three decades. Objects from his collection have been on display throughout the country, including a six-stop museum exhibition, and various objects have been loaned to museums and galleries around the world. Petullo's art collection has been featured in two exhibitions and accompanying catalogues in association with the Milwaukee Art Museum, including "Accidental Genius: Art from the Anthony Petullo Collection" (February 10–May 6, 2012) and the aforementioned travelling exhibition "Driven to Create: The Anthony Petullo Collection of Self-Taught and Outsider Art" (March 11–May 5, 1994). Anthony Petullo's art collection has been featured in several catalogues including *Self-Taught & Outsider Art: The Anthony Petullo Collection*, *Art Without Category: British & Irish Art from the Anthony Petullo Collection* and co-authored the book *Scottie Wilson: Peddler Turned Painter*.

Now retired, Petullo is a longtime member of the Museum's Board of Directors and the Museum's Exhibitions Committee. He is also a member of the Rotary Club of Milwaukee and has received multiple awards for his community service and charitable contributions.

Scope/Content Note

The Papers of the Anthony Petullo include correspondence, photographs of the artists and Mr. Petullo, his personal research, artwork, articles, general ephemera, etc., relating largely to his collecting activities.

Arrangement: The papers are arranged in series by name of artist. Folders within each series are arranged either alphabetically or chronologically, and materials within each folder are arranged chronologically.

Acquisition: Acquired in 2012, the Papers of Anthony Petullo accompanied the Milwaukee Art Museum's acquisition of Petullo's collection of European self-taught art, featured in the exhibition "Accidental Genius: Art from the Anthony Petullo Collection" (February 10–May 6, 2012).

Background Information:

Swiss artist Rosemarie Koczÿ (1939–2007) was born in 1939 near Recklinghausen, Germany. Her family was deported in 1942 to a camp at Traunstein, near Dachau, and later to Ottenhausen near Saarbrücken until 1945. Imprisoned with her family in a Nazi concentration camp during World War II, she was driven by her experiences to create work in which the figures are barely able to emerge from their densely hatched backgrounds. In 1985, Koczÿ's work was chosen by Jean Dubuffet to represent the inaugural exhibition of the Neuve Invention portion of the Collection de l'Art Brut in Lausanne, Switzerland.

Scope/Content Note

Correspondence is arranged by date; ranges from 1994-2005 and includes correspondence from Rosemarie Koczÿ to Anthony Petullo, arranged by, followed by undated greeting cards. Materials have been given an accession number for the study collection and placed in mylar sleeves.
