Satellite Teen Internship offers Milwaukee teens an in-depth discovery of artwork and behind the scenes experiences. We'll work with museum staff and art professionals- to develop a full scope of career development and opportunities within the arts. You'll build confidence in facilitation and presenting artwork to your peers, staff and elementary school children. For your final project, you'll create an innovative collaborative public project that includes a reception held at the Museum.

- **Free internship program**
- Sessions take place at the Milwaukee Art Museum once a week on Thursdays.
- **Free dinner and bus tickets or parking passes** are provided for accepted students.
- You should be interested in the arts, but you do not need to be an artist to apply.

APPLICATIONS ARE DUE ON FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2022 (See program dates on next page)

Select students will be contacted by phone for an interview. Accepted students have to attend a mandatory Onboarding paperwork session at the Museum. Program begins Thursday, October 6th, 2022.

- Answer the questions** on the next page.
- Get a letter of recommendation** from a teacher or mentor supporting your application for this program.
- Mail or drop off** application; due at MAM Sept. 16, 2022 (see other side for mailing address)

ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for this internship, you must:

- Be between the ages of 16–18 years' old
- Be in grade 11 or 12 for the 2022-2023 school year
- **Attend a Milwaukee-area high school**
- ****Per Federal guidelines, you must be legally authorized to work in the United States. You must provide either: A US Passport or Permanent Resident Card OR Two ID's, one ID from List B and one ID from list C:**
 - **List B includes:** Driver's License, Wisconsin State ID, School ID with a photograph.
 - **List C includes:** Social Security Card, Birth Certificate
- Send in a completed application (see left)
- Pass a Background Check
- Attend In-person onboarding session for paperwork after acceptance into program
- You **must** have a checking/savings account opened **in your own name** in order to be paid. Direct Deposit is mandatory for employment at MAM. ****Parents/Guardians can be the primary account holder but the child's name must be on the account where direct deposit will be made.**

3. This program involves a lot of collaboration with teens you will be meeting for the first time. Tell us about (1) your experience collaborating and working with other students, and (2) what qualities you have that will make you a great team player in this program (3) what qualities would you like to work on or change?
4. In this program, Teens learn about artwork and teach it creatively to both elementary school students and other teens. Tell us about (1) any experience you have working with children, and (2) what a good leader is, and the qualities you have that will help you grow into a strong leader (3) what leadership qualities would you like to work on or change?
